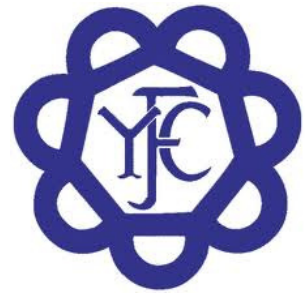
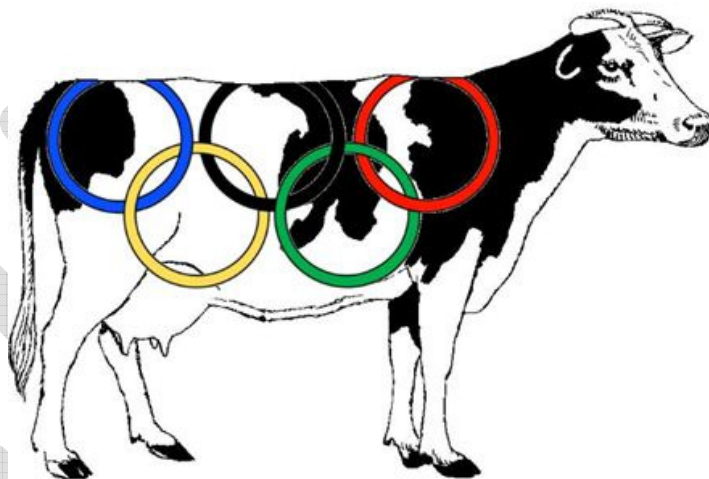

105. CLUB EXHIBIT – THEME ‘OUR CLUB’ (DISPLAY AREA 1mx1mx1m)

An exhibit to provide information about your club to potential new members. Display as much information as possible about visits & meetings, fundraising events/activities and contact details.

The following 4 items must be included:

- **CLUB SCRAPBOOK**
- **CURRENT OFFICERS LIST**
- **A POSTER TO ENCOURAGE NEW MEMBERS TO YOUR CLUB**
- **MINIMUM OF 4 PHOTOGRAPHS**

106. A SIGN TO ADVERTISE THE RALLY DAY – TO BE PUT UP WITHIN YOUR AREA ON PRIVATE LAND (WITH PERMISSION) BY SATURDAY 14TH APRIL 2012.

Entries will be judged by photographic evidence of the sign being advertised at its particular landmark. The photograph must be accompanied by the actual sign itself on the rally day. The sign will be displayed on the RALLY site during RALLY DAY.

LOCATION OF THE SIGN AND CONTACT NUMBER TO BE PROVIDED WITH ENTRY FORM.

The following must be included on your sign:

107. NATIONAL – CUBE EXHIBIT (THE CUBE MUST BE MADE + FULLY ASSEMBLED BEFORE THE RALLY DAY)

(Please read the national rules for this competition which are included at the back of this handicrafts schedule)

Each exhibit to depict the theme of **“Olympics”**. Each whole Exhibit to have a **MAXIMUM WIDTH** of 1 metre at any given point and a **MAXIMUM DEPTH** of 1 metre and **MAXIMUM HEIGHT** of 1 metre. **Any exhibit exceeding the maximum measurements will be disqualified. The measurement will be taken from outside the square.** Each exhibit to include the following 5 items related to the theme:

- 1.1. Design an Olympic Medal inc Ribbon – suitable to be presented to a winning athlete. Any Olympic sport may be depicted
- 1.2. A Collage using Wool to depict an Olympic Sport – no larger than A2 size
- 1.3. To Make a new Olympic Mascot – any materials may be used
- 1.4. A floral Arrangement to depict the Olympic Torch – any size and dimension within the overall dimension
- 1.5. A Decorated Cake (Dummy Cakes can be used) – to depict an Olympic sport

The exhibit must have 3 walls.

Rally 2012 HANDICRAFT RULES

General rules

1. All entries must be submitted by **FRIDAY 16th March 2012**. Late entries will not be accepted.
2. Exhibits **MUST** be displayed with the competitor's number card. Cards will be sent to Club Secretaries prior to the Rally.
3. The handicrafts shed will be open on Friday 18th May 2012 between 7.00 pm and 9.00 pm (entries will be left at competitors own risk). On Saturday 19th May 2012 the shed will be open between 8.00 am and 10.00 am. There will be no vehicular access to the shed.
4. All entries must be displayed by 10.00 am on Saturday 19th May. Exhibitors are requested to place their entries and then leave the shed immediately. The items must be **no bigger** than the specified display area stated in the Rally Handicraft Schedule. Any entries that do not fit within the measurements stated will be disqualified.
5. The Handicrafts area will be **CLOSED** during judging.
6. No exhibits will be removed before **4.00 pm**. Any item removed prior will be disqualified. Points will be deducted on an individual basis for placed exhibits, & on a club basis for unplaced entries (5 points per item). All exhibits must be removed by **5.30 pm** on the day of the Rally.
7. The judge's decision is final and any item exhibited which the judge deems not to be the work of the exhibitor will be disqualified at the judge's discretion.
8. Any exhibitor entering an item, which has been entered at a previous show or Rally, will be disqualified.
9. Any exhibit not as per schedule or 'obscene' will be removed and disqualified.
10. Only 1 entry per person, per class. There is no limit to the number of classes any individual may enter. Entries are encouraged from more than one member per club.
11. **All cookery entries must be covered with cling film or cellophane. All preserve should be covered with cellophane covers** – no coloured covers permitted.
12. Entries received from non-paid up members will be disqualified in any, but open classes.
13. Open classes are open to non-YFC members e.g. WI, YFC members may also enter.

14. **The Points System:** There is no limit to the number of entries. 2 Points will be awarded per entry per class. Any entry that fails to arrive at the Rally by the appointed time will be subject to a deduction of 5 points. For example, if WEDMORE YFC have 4 entries in class 1, and only 2 entries arrive, 8 points will be gained, but a deduction of 10 points will be made from the overall score.

Each member who is placed 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th will be credited with the following:

1 st	10 Points
2 nd	8 Points
3 rd	6 Points
4 th	4 Points

In Open classes, points will be awarded to paid up YFC members and Associate members.

15. Whilst every care is taken to ensure that no damage occurs to exhibits on the day, the Federation and the organising Group cannot accept responsibility for any loss or damage. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to collect exhibits, NOT earlier than 4.00 pm on the day.
16. Exhibitor's complaints will only be considered where the exhibitor feels his/her entry has not been judged, or unfairly disqualified. All such complaints must be lodged with the Handicrafts Chairman no later than **3.00 pm** on the day of the Rally. All complaints must be in writing and accompanied by a deposit of £5.00, which will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.
17. No entries to be cancelled once they have been entered.
18. The Rally Committee accepts **NO** responsibility for loss or injury to persons
Property
19. NFYFC Classes in Cookery, Floristry and Art/Craft Sections – All rules apply except members will not be expected to cook/arrange their entries at the rally. Time restrictions therefore do not apply. Size/staging requirements do apply. Members are encouraged to read the NFYFC rules carefully. Somerset YFC will encourage the exhibitors of the winning entries in these classes to represent the county at the National Competitions Day where they will have to produce their entries in front of a judge and within the time limits stated.

N.B Please make sure that the appropriate entry forms are completed and submitted to SFYFC County Offices no later than FRIDAY 16th MARCH 2012. Additional forms are available should more than 4 club members wish to enter a class. If possible it would be our preferred preference that these forms are completed electronically and submitted electronically. However, handwritten entry forms will be accepted.
